The London Olympics 2012 and the Brooke House College Summer School

Statement

The London Olympics will start on 27th July and finish on 12th August 2012. Most of the Olympic venues are in and around London.

Brooke House College is in Market Harborough, which is far enough from London for our students not to be adversely affected by the increased business of the capital or the increased cost of flights to the capital's airports. Where possible, we advise that students avoid flying to London airports and instead book tickets in and out of Birmingham and East Midlands. We further advise that flights are booked nice and early to avoid higher-than-normal prices.

We are excited about the Games taking place "on our doorstep" during the Summer School. The Olympics will provide us with a unique additional excursion for London, where students will be able to visit the main Olympic Park venues and get a feel for the atmosphere of the London Games. We are in touch with a specialist travel company for the Olympics and discussing the possibility of arranging overnight visits to the Games, including tickets to sporting events, for Summer School students. As and when these arrangements are finalised, details will be posted on our website and sent to registered students. These trips will be offered as options to the Summer School students and provided at additional cost. Deposit and Payment: The deposit is included in the total fees. This amount is 100% non-refundable except where a student fails in his application for a UK visa. Full payment is due four weeks before the beginning of the course.

Cancellations: Fees (minus the deposit) are fully refundable in the case of cancellations made outside of the period 4 weeks before the beginning of the course. Fees are non-refundable in case of cancellations made within 4 weeks of the beginning of the course except where a student fails to obtain a visa. Refunds may be made at the discretion of the College in the event of serious illness, accident or death relating to the student or close family member before the start of or during the course.

Liability: It shall be a condition of the contract between the parties that Brooke House College shall not be in any way liable for services contracted to supply where those services become impossible to supply owing to reasons beyond the control of Brooke House College.

The English Plus Course is designed for students who already have a good grasp of the English Language and whose level is Pre-Intermediate or above. English Plus students do not take part in activities in the afternoon but, instead, attend three hours of additional classes every afternoon except Wednesday. The afternoon classes incorporate British Culture topics into English Language learning (see **UK Culture topics** below). On Wednesdays, English Plus students join the half-day excursion with all other students.

IELTS Preparation – 27 hours of English plus activities/excursions

Course information and Sample Programme

The IELTS preparation course is designed for students who already have a good grasp of the English Language and whose level is Intermediate or above. Students who enrol on the IELTS Preparation course should be at least 16 years of age and in senior school in their home countries. Most students who are taking the IELTS Preparation course will either be starting or considering starting academic courses in UK in the future.

IELTS Preparation takes place every weekday morning in designated IELTS classes with specialist IELTS teachers. Every afternoon except Wednesday, the students attend three hours of additional classes. These classes incorporate British Culture topics into English Language learning (see **UK Culture topics** below). On Wednesdays, IELTS Preparation students join the half-day excursion with all other students.

Students on this course have the option to take an IELTS examination in Cambridge in the final week of the course. Please note that there is an additional charge of £160.00 for students who choose to sit the optional IELTS examination.

English Plus Football – 15 hours English plus 7.5 hours of Football plus activities/excursions

Course information and Sample Programme for a two-week stay

Since 2009 Brooke House Summer School has been joining forces with the Brooke House College Football Academy to run an English Plus Football Course for Summer School Students. The Brooke House College Football Academy is managed by professionally trained UEFA A and B coaches and a trained sports injury specialist and physiotherapist. Every Tuesday, Thursday and Friday afternoon, English Plus Football students train for 2.5 hours with the Football Academy on top-grade rubber crumb (3G grass) football pitches.

The sessions encompass:

- Warm-up
- Technical and skills exercises
- Small-sided games and tournaments

A small number of class based sessions cover:

- Tactics
- Nutrition and fluid intake
- Prevention of injury

On Monday afternoons, English Plus Football students join the regular afternoon activity.

On Wednesday afternoons the English Plus Football students join the half-day excursion.
