### CONVENIENT CENTRAL LOCATION

**1 HIGH STREET**  
A teaching building consisting of 14 classrooms and four art labs. Home of the Art, Languages, Maths and several Social Science departments.



**2 UNION HOUSE**  
Supervised accommodation with a resident tutor for students 16 to 18+. Refurbished and opened in 2013. All rooms are ensuite.



**3 COLLEGE HOUSE (RIGHT)**  
A teaching building consisting of 11 classrooms. Home of the Intensive English, Physical Education, ECDL, Accounting and Business Studies departments.



**4 COVENTRY HOUSE (NOT PICTURED)**  
Supervised accommodation with a resident tutor for students 16 to 18+.

**A THE ANGEL HOTEL**  
A 17th century coaching inn, co-owned by the college. Offering discounted prices to visiting parents.



**5 HEYGATE LABS (NOT PICTURED)**  
Two fully equipped labs. Home of the Biology Department.

**6 LONDON HOUSE**  
Over 18 accommodation under the direction of a live-in Warden. 4 houses and 5 apartments (all single gender). Ensuite available.



**7 PAUL KITCHENER BUILDING**  
A supervised study centre during the school day, Monday to Friday. A supervised social centre in the evening, at weekends and during half term holidays. Contains a TV room with a 4m large screen connected to games consoles and SKY TV, a pool room, a table tennis room and a snack shop.



**8 NORTHAMPTON HOUSE**  
Supervised accommodation with a resident tutor for students 16 to 18+. Ensuite available.



**9 HARBOURH TOWN FOOTBALL CLUB**  
Home of the Brooke House College Football Academy. Used for morning training and home matches.



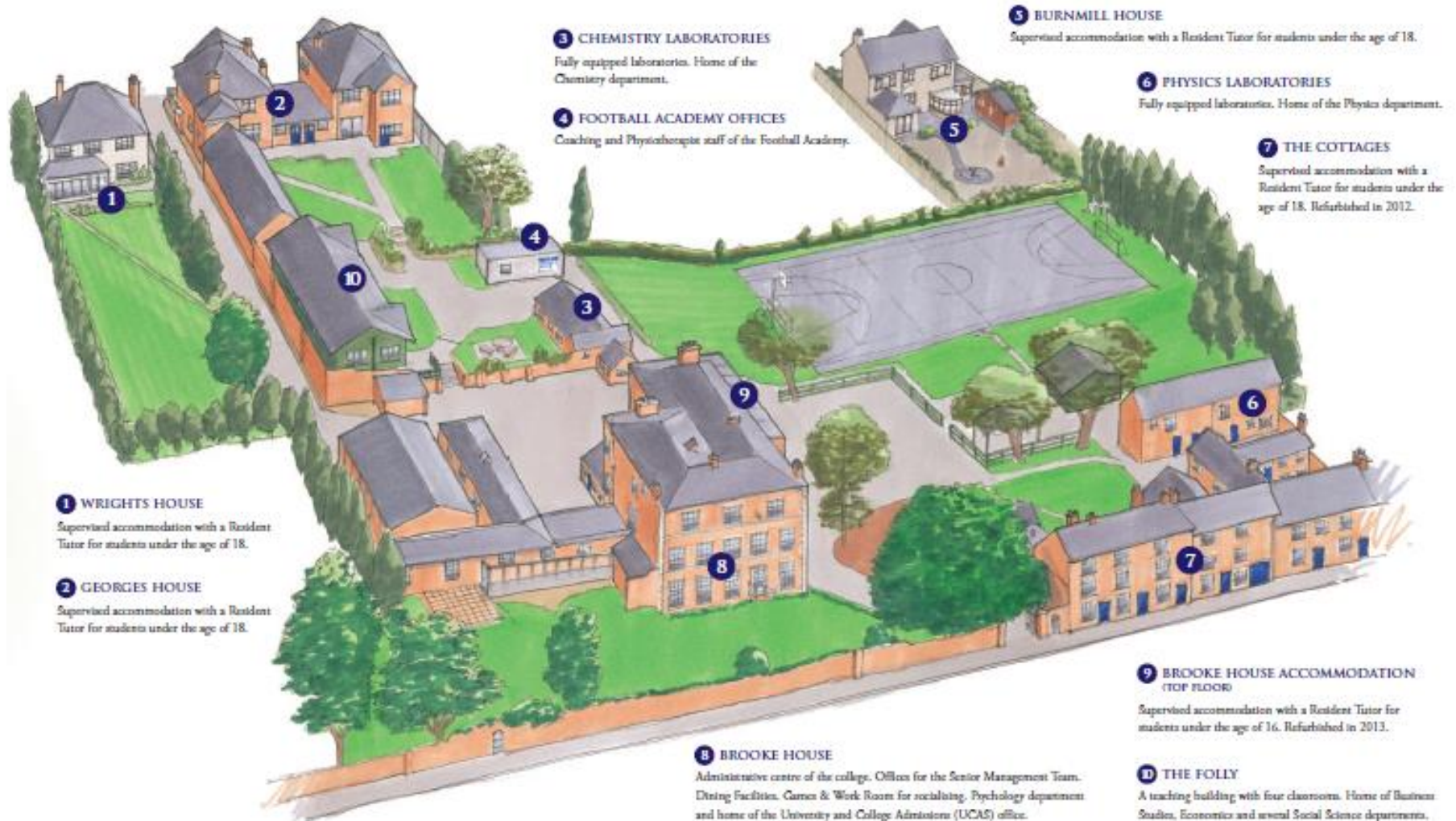
**10 MARKET HARBOURH LEISURE CENTRE**

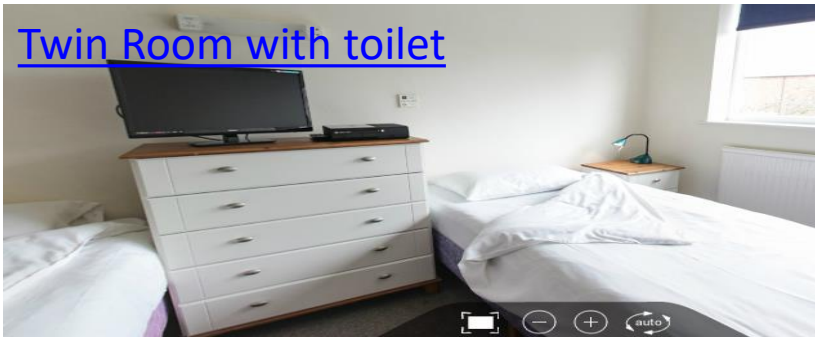

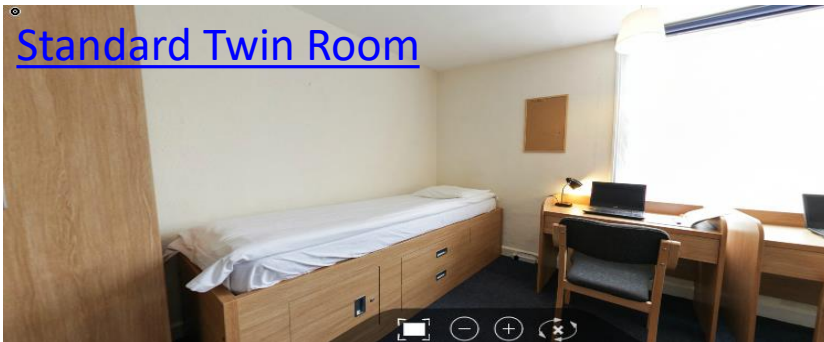

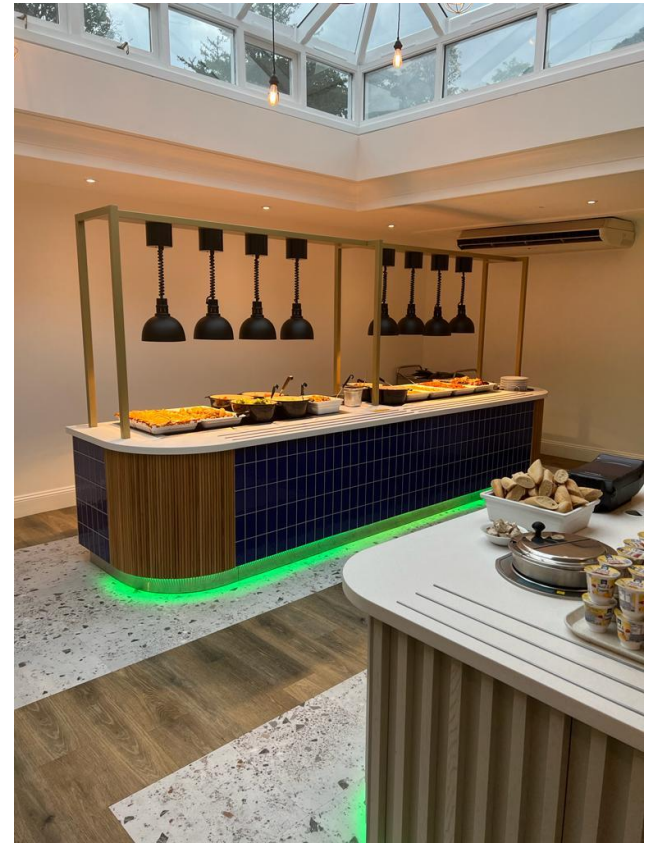
